New Noticeboard

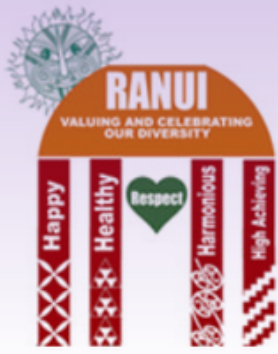

- Sending a note to school with another family member or when your child returns to school.

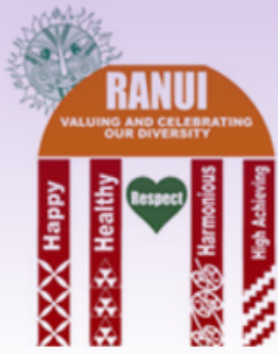


ANZAC Day

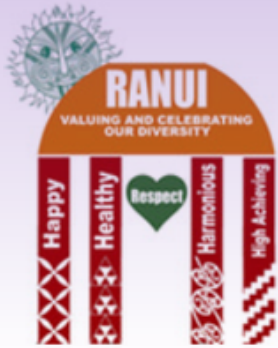

TE WHAKATIPU KĀKANO NOHO MARAE

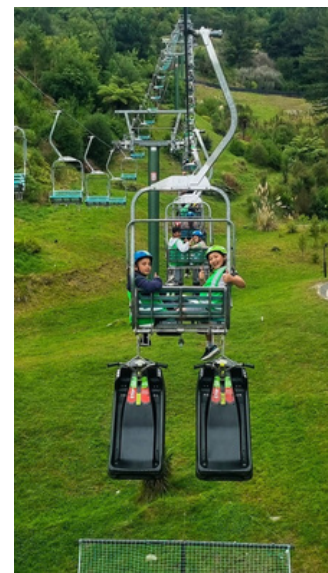

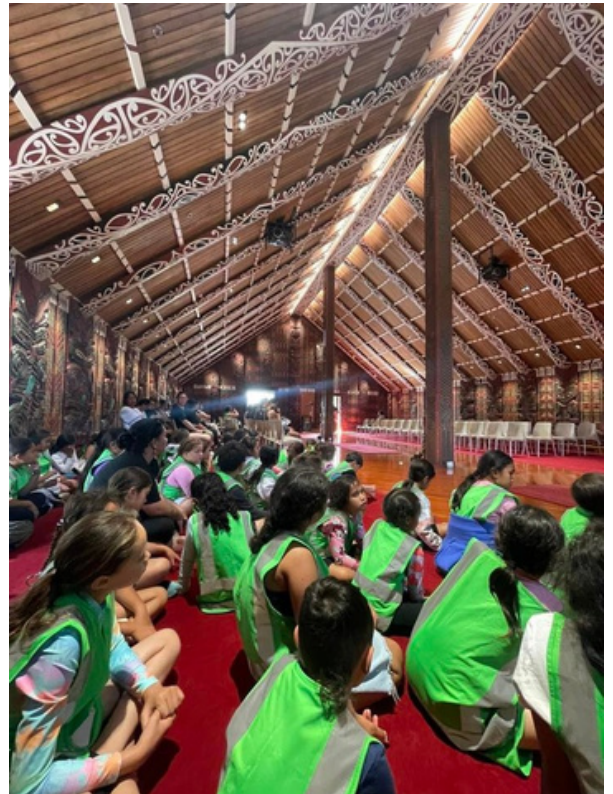

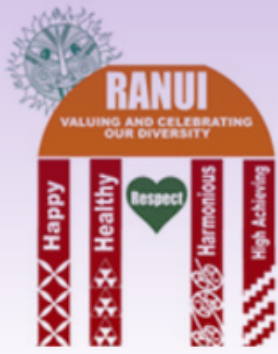
