Inspired by the artworks of Dessa Bluu

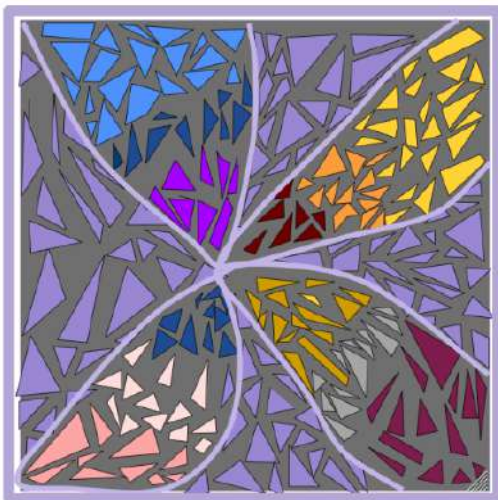
First, we looked at some of Dessa Bluu's art.

Then, (based on one of the patterns Dessa Bluu often uses) we created our own artworks with pastel. It would be cheating and disrespectful to copy her mahi.

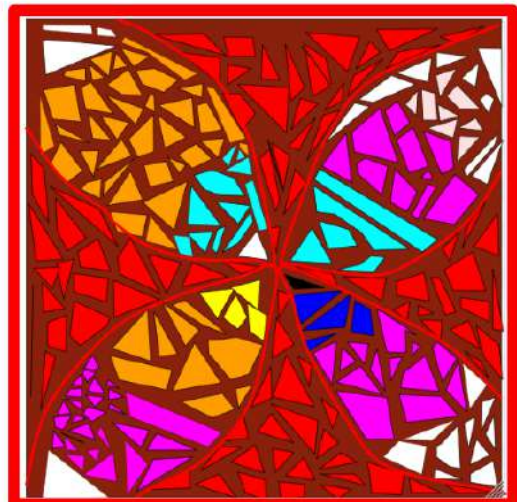

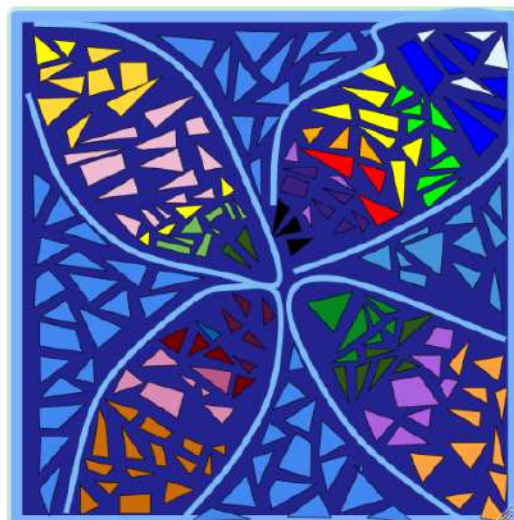
