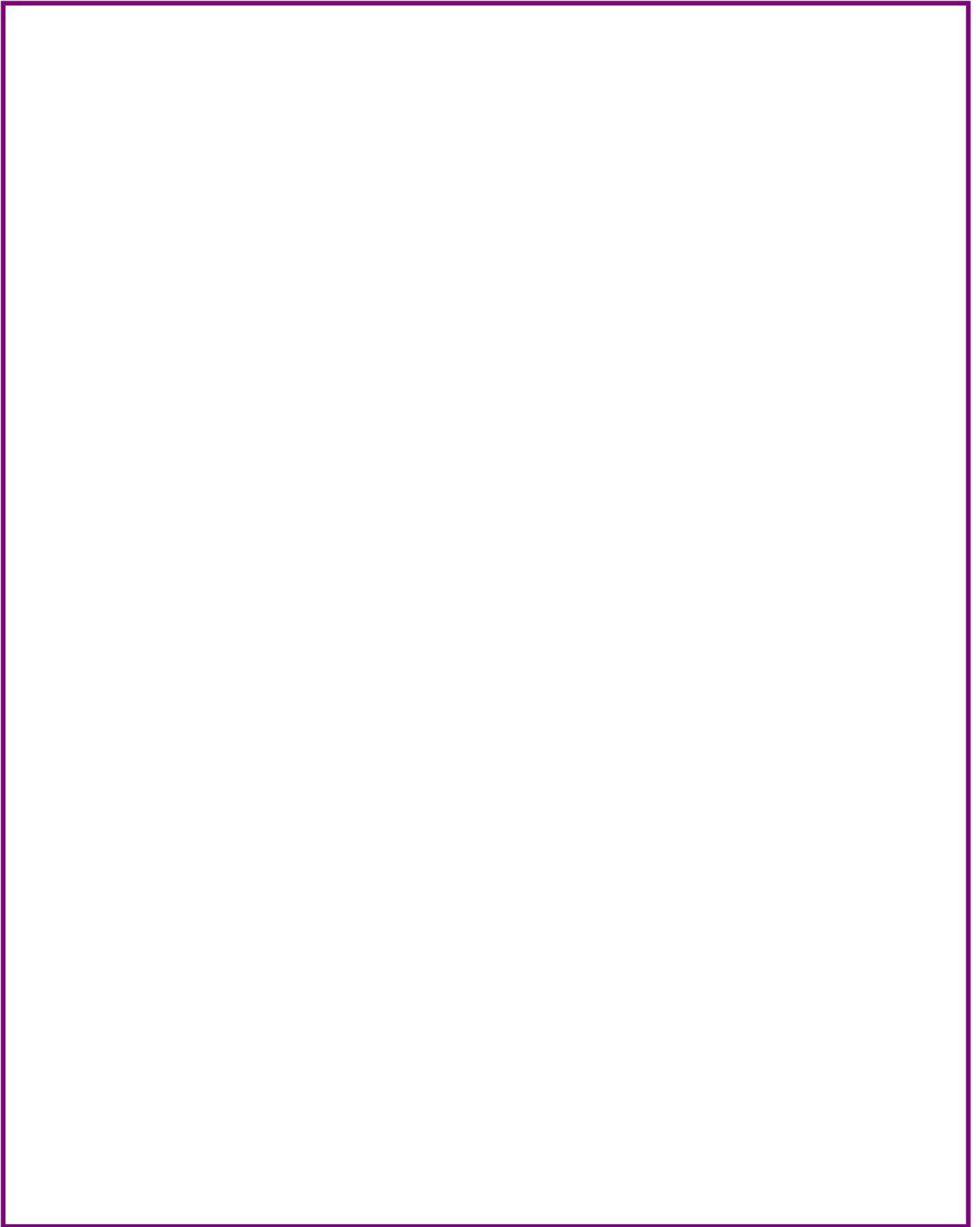
## Athletics Day Sausage Sizzle Ice Blocks

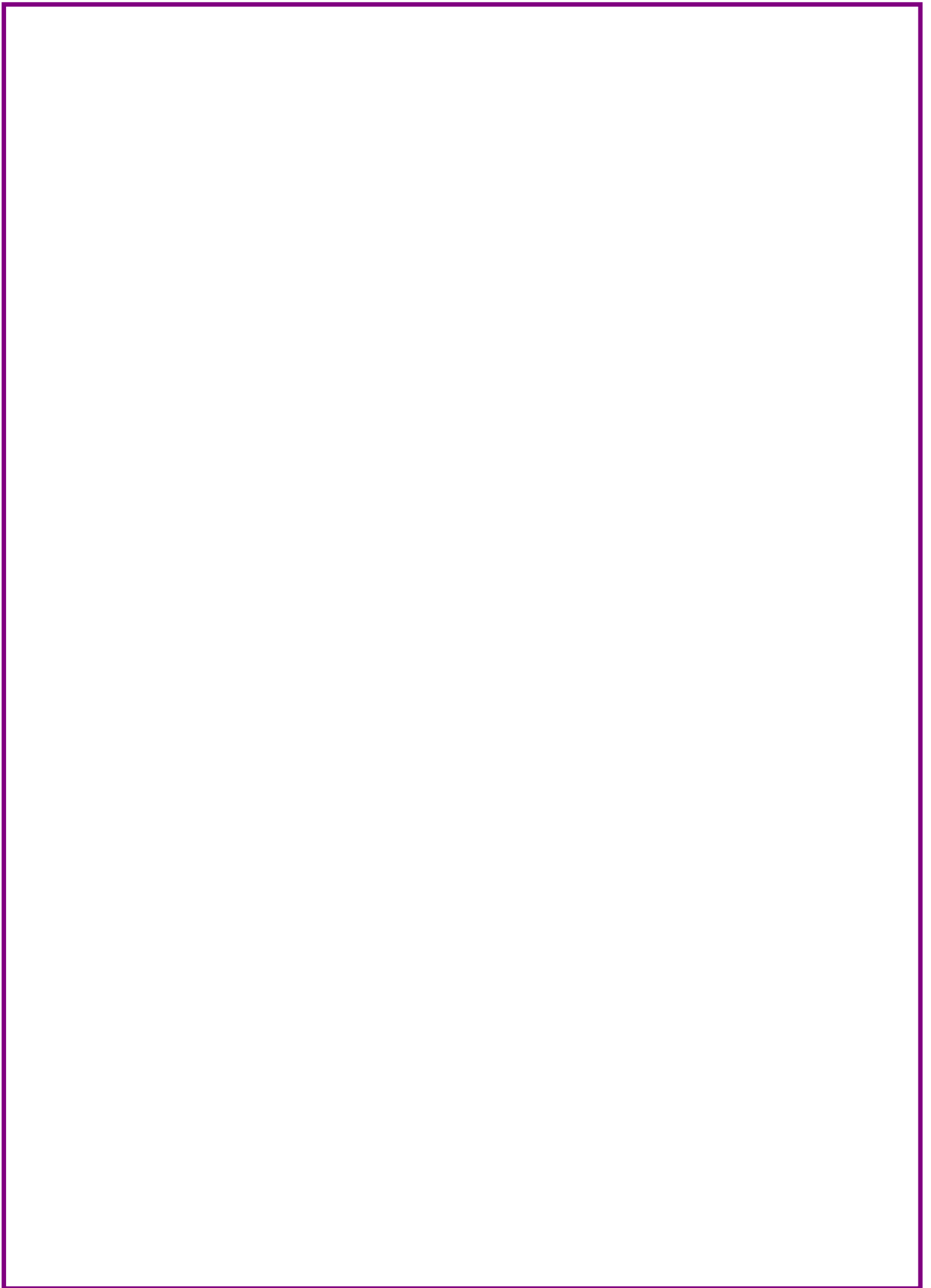

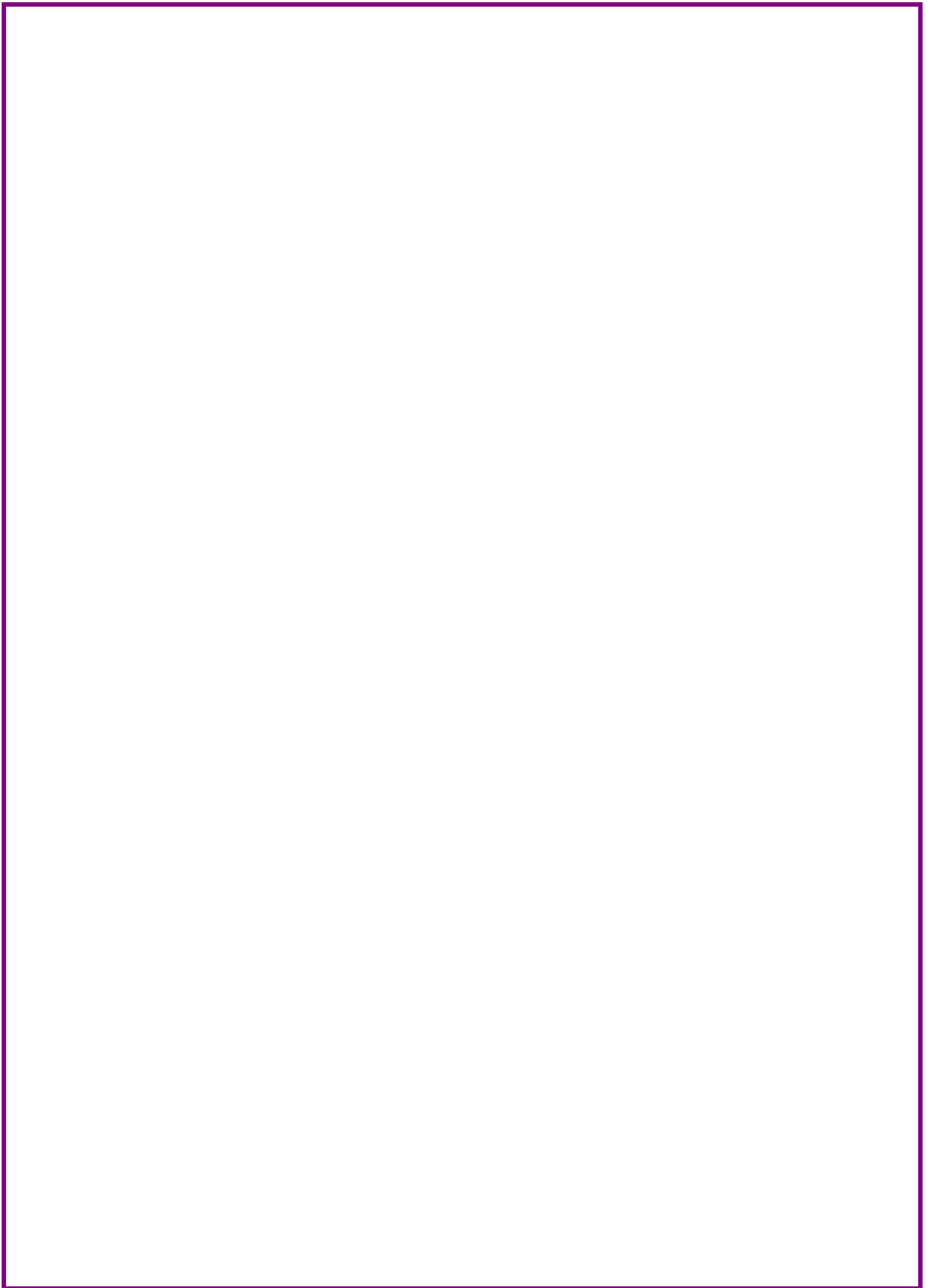
